#### *Housing a Growing America*

Excellent introduction to housing problems facing United States. Produced by the National Association of Home Builders to show how these problems and needs are being met. Included is a brief look at the historical developments in housing in the U.S.

Excellent to illustrate planning techniques in suburbia. Shows examples of communities where green belt areas are included and the impact of total planning on families within these communities. Available for purchase or free loan.
