Human Behavior and Design

Position Description: Cornell University's Department of Design and Environmental Analysis (DEA) (<http://www.human.cornell.edu/che/DEA/index.cfm>) invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track professorial appointment at the Assistant to Full Professor rank, depending on experience and qualifications. This new position is in support of DEA's new Ph.D. program in Human Behavior and Design. This program focuses on the relationship between the planning, design, and management of the built environment as it impacts a wide range of human behaviors (e.g., performance, safety, health, learning, family relations, lifestyle, consumer choices, affective and emotional responses). Candidates may come from disciplines such as human factors/ergonomics, interior design, architecture, industrial design, housing, environmental psychology, and facility planning and management. The person filling this position is expected to teach, and to develop an externally funded program of research on issues related to human behavior and design.

Qualifications: A Ph.D. is required.

Rank and Salary: This tenure-track professorial position is available July 1, 2008. Appointments are nine months with attractive fringe benefits.

Institution: The Department of Design and Environmental Analysis is one of five multidisciplinary academic units in the College of Human Ecology at Cornell University (<http://www.human.cornell.edu/index.cfm>). Disciplines represented in the Department include psychology, human factors, interior design, architecture, industrial design, housing, engineering, and facilities planning and management. Current faculty research interests include health and design, the workplace, residential environments, children and the environment, human factors, environmental stressors, sustainability and social responsibility, and the history of interior design. The College carries out the threefold land-grant mission of resident teaching, research, and Extension/outreach.
