

CALL FOR PAPERS KITCHEN & BATH DESIGN
***Housing and Society* 2004 – 05 Fall Issue**

The National Kitchen and Bath Association (NKBA) and the Center for Kitchen and Bath Education and Research (CKBER) in collaboration with the Housing Education and Research Association (HERA) announces the first ever call for papers on kitchen and bath design. Selected papers will be published in *Housing and Society*, the official journal for HERA. The journal is distributed to HERA members as well as libraries around the world, and additional copies of this special issue will be distributed through NKBA.

The HERA journal publication will be a special issue dedicated to kitchen and bath design, tentatively scheduled for publication in the fall of 2005. Papers published will be authored primarily by NKBA Endorsed Programs educators and NKBA member adjunct faculty. There are three paper categories.

Category 1: Part-time Adjunct Professor that is an NKBA industry member currently working in the industry.

Papers in Category 1 should be written as a commentary or in note style in 3-10 double-spaced pages plus illustrations. Topics could include: (a) exploratory analysis of a kitchen and bath design or industry related problem; (b) presentation of an innovative teaching idea or strategy for kitchen and bath design; (c) discussion of current or projected trends in the kitchen and bath industry; and (d) overview of best practices within the kitchen and bath industry.

Category 2: Full-time NKBA educator collaborating on research with an NKBA registered member firm.

Category 3: NKBA or HERA member full-time educator conducting research in the kitchen and bath industry.

Papers in Category 2 and Category 3 should be written as a full academic article focusing on research, teaching techniques, NKBA programs and firms, or application strategies. Papers should follow APA style, include references, and be 15-20 double-spaced pages plus illustrations.

All papers need to have an approximately 200 word abstract, author identification information on a separate page, and be double-spaced using Times New Roman Font 12. Illustrations are strongly encouraged. Please send original drawings and color photographs or tif or eps graphic files (300 dpi). Refer to Manuscript Style Guidelines at www.housingeducators.org. Papers will undergo a review process involving NKBA educators, the NKBA Endorsed Programs Manager, and the Executive Editor of *Housing and Society*.

At least three papers from each category will be included in the special issue of *Housing and Society*, and top papers will be presented at a future NKBA Conference. NKBA industry members that collaborate with educators on research in Category 2 will receive a special Presidential Award and mention in *Profiles*.
